Healthy outdoor taking place in nature led by Big Game Parks

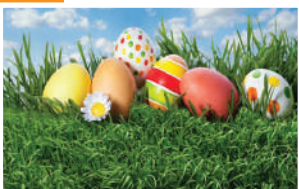
